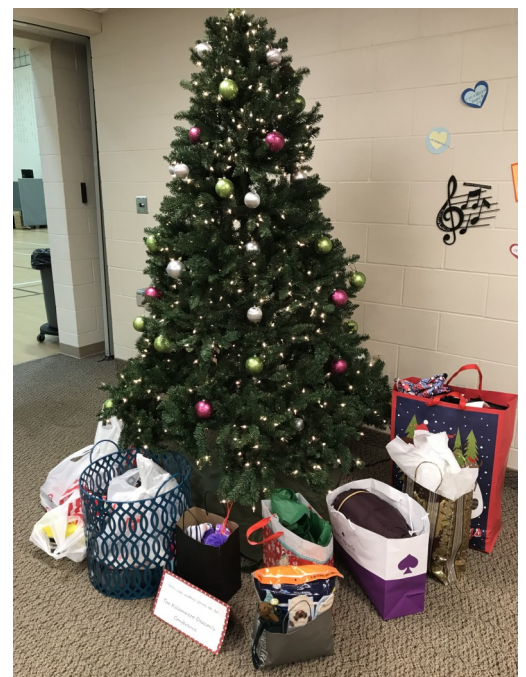

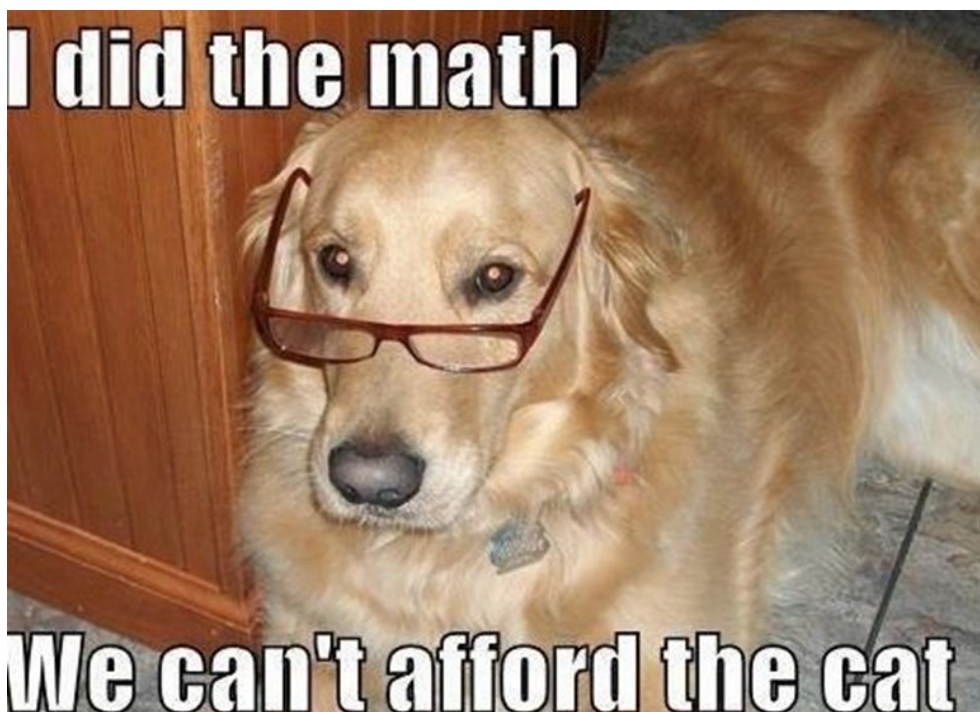

May. They were married for almost 48 years.

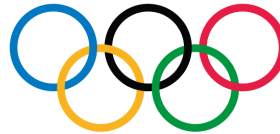

Winter Recipe

Nutella Hot Chocolate



Need a gift idea?

Hot Chocolate mix in a jar
or
Cookie mix in a jar!

Ingredients:

- 4 cups lot fat/skim milk
- 2 TBS Nutella
- 2 TBS unsweetened cocoa powder
- 2 TBS natural sweetener of choice

Optional Toppings:

- Marshmallows
- Crushed Hazelnuts
- Chocolate Chips
- Extra Nutella

Directions:

1. Heat milk in a medium sized saucepan on medium-high heat beginning to warm and steam. Add the Nutella, cocoa powder, and sugar and whisk until dissolved and combined. Bring to a gentle simmer while stirring, and take off heat.
